





Looking for a unique pool field trip for your Summer group outing? Look no further and join us for a fun day in the sun at SandVenture Aquatic Park! Our unique facility offers a chlorinated and filtered sand bottom pool. Our pool is surrounded by a sand beach with play toys and has a 300' water slide, two 12' drop slides, a 10' tot-slide, and a diving board. Our park shelter has family changing rooms, locker rooms, a picnic area as well as a concession stand.

- Please reserve your visit more than one week prior to the date you would like to visit.
- Once your deposit is received and processed the organization representative will receive an email confirmation.
- Final payment will be on the day of the visit and can be done via cash, local check (Shakopee addresses only), or credit card.
- There will be no refunds issued unless the park closes due to weather
- There are no discounts for guests who have a membership or punch card.
- Groups must provide active supervision at the following <u>minimum</u> ratios. We reserve the right to
  refuse admission to groups who do not follow this ratio with no refunds.
  - 1 supervisor to 3 participants for children under the age of 5
  - o 1 supervisor to 6 participants for children ages 5 to 9
  - o 1 supervisor to 10 participants for children 10 and older

## \*\* Active supervision means that supervisors must be in the water with the children actively watching and interacting with the participants.

- It is the responsibility of the organization to know each child's limitations. If attending with children with special needs, a lower supervisor to child ratio is advised.
- Supervisors must be at least 16 years old
- A representative of the group must check-in with the Aquatic Park Supervisor prior to letting the group off the bus and/or using the facility
- If a child needs to leave the group (such as to use the restroom) a supervisor must accompany that child.
- Only US Coast Guard approved floatation devices can be used

Reservation times are limited to 11:00am – 7:00pm for public groups. See open dates on the current reservation form. Remember to get your information as soon as you can as dates fill fast.
