



<u>LABELING SMOKE AND FIRE RATED WALLS</u> (2015 MSFC and 2015 MSBC)

Code Reference - MSBC 703.7 - Marking and Identification

703.7 Marking and identification. *Fire walls, fire barriers, fire partitions, smoke barriers* and smoke partitions or any other wall required to have protected openings or penetrations shall be effectively and permanently identified with signs or stenciling. Such identification shall:

- 1. Be located in accessible concealed floor, floor-ceiling or attic spaces;
- 2. Be located within 15 feet (4572 mm) of the end of each wall and at intervals not exceeding 30 feet (9144 mm) measured horizontally along the wall or partition; and
- 3. Include lettering not less than 3 inches (76 mm) in height with a minimum 3/8-inch (9.5 mm) stroke in a contrasting color incorporating the suggested wording. "FIRE AND/OR SMOKE BARRIER—PROTECT ALL OPENINGS" or other wording.

Exception: Walls in Group R-2 occupancies that do not have a removable decorative ceiling allowing access to the concealed space.

General Requirements

- 1. The requirements set forth in this policy shall be in effect for new and existing construction.
- 2. All penetrations through smoke control or fire rated walls shall by sealed with an approved material.

Specific Requirements

- 1. The requirements set forth in this policy shall be in effect for all occupancies.
- 2. In areas with removable ceiling tile the labeling may be placed above the tile.
- 3. Where the required label would be visible to the public a small label may be allowed to be placed on window and/or door frames with the approval of the code official.

Example

1. Smoke rated walls shall be labeled in the following manner:

SMOKE BARRIER - PROTECT ALL OPENINGS

2. Fire rated walls shall be labeled in the following manner:

FIRE BARRIER (RATING) - PROTECT ALL OPENINGS

Example: FIRE BARRIER (1-HR) – PROTECT ALL OPENINGS

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
