



## <u>DUCT SMOKE DETECTORS</u> (2015 MSFC)

- 1. Duct smoke detectors shall be provided in accordance with the Minnesota State Mechanical Code.
- 2. Duct smoke detectors shall shut down the affected unit and submit a trouble signal to the fire alarm panel.
- 3. Duct smoke detectors shall be provided with remote test stations.
- 4. Duct smoke detectors shall be resettable from the fire alarm panel or shall be provided with remote reset stations.
- 5. Remote test and remote reset stations shall be permanently mounted at a height not to exceed 12 feet above finished floor.
- 6. Remote test and remote reset stations should be located below the unit being controlled.
- 7. Remote test, remote reset stations and each unit shall be labeled with the a corresponding number.
