



<u>DUCT SMOKE DETECTORS</u> (2020 MSFC)

- 1. Duct smoke detectors shall be provided in accordance with the Minnesota State Mechanical Code.
- 2. Duct smoke detectors shall shut down the affected unit and submit a trouble signal to the fire alarm panel.
- 3. Duct smoke detectors shall be provided with remote test stations.
- 4. Duct smoke detectors shall be resettable from the fire alarm panel or shall be provided with remote reset stations.
 - a. Where a building is required to have a fire alarm system in accordance with the Minnesota State Fire Code the duct smoke detectors shall be connected to the fire alarm system.
 - b. When no fire alarm system is required duct smoke detectors shall provide a visual and audible signal at and approved location.
- 5. Remote test and remote reset stations shall be permanently mounted at a height not to exceed 12-feet above finished floor.
- 6. Remote test and remote reset stations should be located below the unit being controlled.
- 7. Remote test, remote reset stations and each unit shall be labeled with the a corresponding number.
