

2022 FULL DEPTH PAVEMENT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

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APRIL 2022

CONTRACT

Shakopee City Council awarded a contract for the 2022 Full Depth Pavement Reconstruction to the low bidder, Northwest Asphalt, of Shakopee, MN on March 15th, 2022.

PROJECT LOCATION

- Weston Court and Greenwood Court
- Gorman Street

PROJECT SCOPE

The project consists of full depth pavement reclamation of the existing bituminous roadways. The reclaimed material will be utilized as aggregate base and a new bituminous surface will be paved. The new pavement section will consist of 10-inches of reclaimed aggregate base and 5-inches of bituminous asphalt. Broken concrete driveway aprons, sidewalk and curb and gutter will also be replaced as part of the project. ADA deficient pedestrian curb ramps will be reconstructed.

The bituminous trail along Gorman Street will be reclaimed and a new bituminous surface will be paved. The wood pole streetlights along Gorman Street will be upgraded to aluminum poles with LED light fixtures.

New sidewalk will be constructed along the north and east side of Greenwood Court. Sidewalk along Weston Court will be extended to the cul-de-sac. A new aluminum pole streetlight with LED fixture will be installed at the northwest corner of Greenwood Court and 17th Avenue. Small segments of broken storm sewer will also be replaced on Greenwood Court.

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ROAD & DRIVEWAY ACCESS

It is our intent to maintain access to your driveway throughout the project. There will be occasional short-term disruptions to access during utility excavation and construction. Residents should expect full access from 7pm to 7am each day. In addition, there will be 7 days after concrete curb and gutter and concrete driveways are constructed when access will be restricted to allow the concrete to cure. Please contact Adam, to discuss any special considerations or related hardship issues.

LANDSCAPING

Please remove all landscaping and vegetation you want to save in the city right-of-way, from the curb to approximately 10 feet back. Contact Adam if you would like to know the removal limits and/or impacts adjacent to your property.

SPRINKLERS & DOG FENCES

The city right-of-way extends approximately 15 feet from back of the existing curb and gutter. Please mark any underground pet fencing and mark the portions of your sprinkler system within the city right-of-way as soon as possible. Contact Adam if any fence or sprinkler is damaged during construction.
