

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-009

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHAKOPEE, MINNESOTA,
AMENDING SECTION 71.04 OF THE SHAKOPEE CITY CODE
RELATING TO RECREATIONAL VEHICLE AND TRAILER PARKING**

The City Council of Shakopee, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. Section 71.04 of the Shakopee City Code is amended to read as follows:

71.04 House Trailer, Mobile Home, Camping Trailer, Utility Trailer, Boat Trailers, and Bus Parking

In addition to the prohibitions listed in 71.02, it is unlawful for any person to leave or park a house trailer, mobile home, camping trailer, utility trailer, boat trailer, bus, or other similar recreational vehicle on or within the limits of any street or right-of-way, except where signs are erected designating the place as a campsite, for more than 24 consecutive hours; provided, however, that during such 24-hour period, such vehicle shall not be occupied as living quarters.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its adoption and publication.
