



2023 BITUMINOUS OVERLAY PROJECT

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PROJECT SCOPE

The project consists of milling the surface of the roadway, crack repair, patching areas of pavement failure and then paving a bituminous overlay. Broken and settled concrete curb and gutter and ADA deficient pedestrian ramps will be reconstructed prior to milling of the surface.

SCHEDULE UPDATE

Area A: All work in this area is complete, apart from sod installation in locations throughout the project area. The contractor will install sod once temperatures have cooled to prevent sod from dying in the heat.

If you have an irrigation system that was damaged and it has not been repaired or was repaired incorrectly, please contact Alex Enyi.

Area B: All work in this area is complete.

Area C: The contractor anticipates starting work the week of July 17th. The contractor will begin with concrete removal of existing pedestrian curb ramps

Area D: The contractor anticipates starting work the week of July 17th. The contractor will begin with concrete removal of existing pedestrian curb ramps

SPRINKLERS & DOG FENCES

Broken and settled concrete will be removed and replaced. Please mark the portions of your sprinkler system and/or underground fence adjacent to curb and gutter as soon as possible. The contractor will make the best attempt to protect sprinkler systems and dog fences but will be responsible for fixing them if damaged during construction.

ROAD & DRIVEWAY ACCESS

It is our intent to maintain access to the driveways throughout the project. There will be occasional short-term disruptions due to milling and paving operations.

WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Please do not walk or drive on new concrete for 7 days. When the contractor is working on your street, please be patient and for everyone's safety, please follow the directions given by the workers. Shortly before overlaying the roadway, the contractor will apply a bituminous tack coat to the surface. **We recommend that you avoid driving on this tack coat as it may track onto your driveway from your tires.** Also, please avoid driving on the fresh pavement until it has been rolled and avoid parking on it until it has had a chance to cool.


2023 BITUMINOUS OVERLAY PROJECT LOCATION MAP
