NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that bids for the **Southbridge Lift Station Rehabilitation Project - Sewer 23-002** will be received online through Quest CDN vBid™ until **10:00 am local time Tuesday November 14, 2023**. Immediately following the expiration of the time for receiving bids, representatives of the City Council for the City of Shakopee, will publicly view Bids at an online Bid Opening Meeting. Description of work:

Rehabilitation of an existing Lift Station including the following:

- New Pumps
- New Valves
- Remove and replace bituminous driveway.
- Controls upgrades

Bids shall be submitted online no later than the date and time prescribed. For this project, the City will only be accepting online electronic bids through QuestCDN. To access the electron bid form, download the project documents and click the online bidding button at the top of the advertisement.

Prospective bidders must be on the planholders list through QuestCDN for bids to be accepted. The provisions of the Minnesota Statute 16C.285 Responsible Contractor are imposed as a requirement of this contract. All bidders and persons or companies providing a responsive/submission to this invitation for bids shall comply with the provisions of the statute.

Download the digital bidding documents for \$45.00 by imputing Quest project #8777750 on the website's Project Search Page. The website will be updated periodically with addenda, lists of registered plan holders and other information relevant to submitting a Bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bidding Documents will be offered only through the website www.questcdn.com. Neither Owner or Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from other sources.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond, cash deposit, certified bank letter of credit or certified check made payable to the City of Shakopee, Minnesota, in the amount of 5 percent of the total bid amount, as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed contract within the time specified and at the price bid. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of 45 days from the date of opening of bids.

The Shakopee City Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any defects or technicalities in bidding and to determine whether a bid is responsive or non-responsive. The City Council further reserves the right to make a bid award to the lowest and most responsible bidder as determined by the City Council.
