Stabilize Your Camera

Blurry images can be distracting, so make sure to brace your camera with your arms or a tripod when possible.

Use the Rule of Thirds

By putting the main subject of your photo in one of the thirds of the frame, you will often help create a more pleasing aesthetic.

Be Aware of the Sun

Harsh sunlight can often flatten an image and eliminate depth. Early morning or evening light can provide a sense of mood.







Provide a Unique Perspective

Look for unique angles or vantage points to help tell your story. A great photo often shows us a perspective we wouldn't otherwise see!

Tell a Story with Your Image

Thoughtful intention is often what separates a great photo from a snapshot. If your photo could talk, what story would it be telling?

Look for Pleasing Compositional Elements

Creating a sense of depth with your photo through foreground and background objects or leading lines will help your photo to pop!
