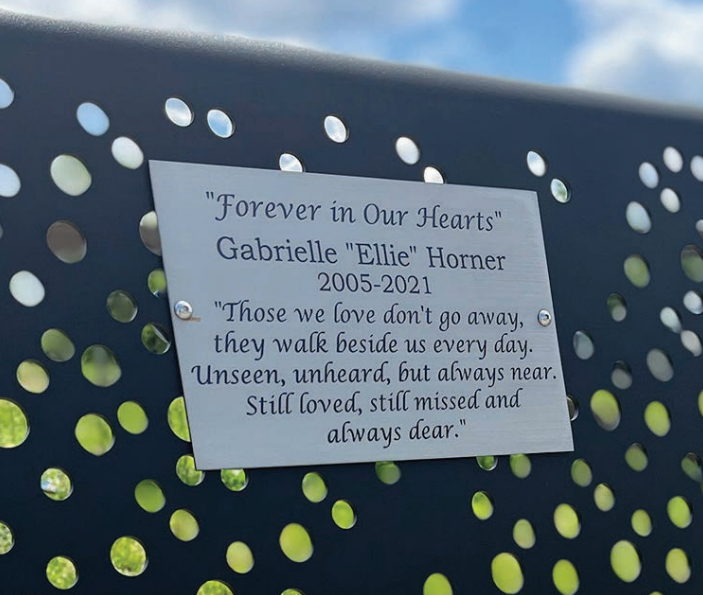

- Honeylocust
- American Linden
- Bur Oak
- Red Oak
- Northern Pin Oak
- River Birch
- Bitternut Hickory
- Shagbark Hickory
- Black Walnut
- Eastern White Pine
- White Spruce
- Black Hills Spruce
- Eastern Red Cedar

### Tree planted during spring/fall season:
