CONTRACT

Shakopee City Council will award a contract for the 2024 Mill and Overlay project to the low bidder, Bituminous Roadways, of Shakopee, MN on April 16th, 2024. There are no direct assessments to property owners on this project.

PROJECT LOCATION

PROJECT SCOPE

The project consists of milling the surface of the roadway, crack repair, patching areas of pavement failure, and then paving a bituminous overlay.

Broken and settled concrete curb and gutter and ADA deficient pedestrian ramps will be reconstructed at the start of the project. The milling of the street, crack repairs and paving of the street will begin following the completion of all concrete work. This work is anticipated to be completed within one to two weeks of milling the streets. The actual paving on your street should take less than a day.

The contractor will be posting temporary signs in the boulevards notifying residents of any parking restrictions during construction. Please use caution and patience while driving in the construction zone and comply with all parking restrictions and temporary traffic control.

APPROXIMATE START DATES BY AREA

The contractor anticipates starting construction the week of April 22^{nd,} but we have not received the schedule by area location. The city will update the city website with a schedule for each area as it becomes available, and we will mail out an updated project newsletter then.
